

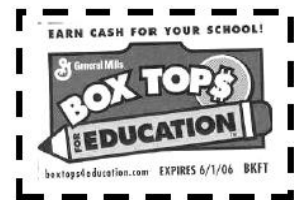


Rooster Springs Elementary PTA raised almost \$3100 last year through redemption programs!!!

How do these Redemption Programs work? When **YOU** use a participating service (such as a grocery or discount store card) or purchase a participating brand product, **OUR SCHOOL receives** monetary compensation. Friends, relatives, or co-workers may also participate in these programs by giving you the box tops or labels or by designating our school to receive credit.

General Mills Box Tops for Education lets you earn cash for our school by collecting Box Tops logos. Each Box Top is worth **10 cents**.

To Participate: Simply cut the Box Tops logo along the dashed line and send it to school with your child (preferably in a zip-top baggie or envelope) to be turned in to the Box Tops for Education drop box in the school's front hall.

Additionally, the Box Tops for Education website provides an online marketplace also allowing you to earn cash for your school simply by shopping at online stores you already patronize. These stores contribute a percentage of your purchase back to your school.

To Participate: Log onto www.boxtops4education.com and register with the site. Then select the Marketplace tab, and then select the store you would like to shop at. As long as you visit the online merchant thru the Box Tops site, your school receives a percentage back, up to 8% or more!

OFFICE DEPOT – 5% Back to Schools Program. If you purchase qualifying school supplies at Office Depot, Office Depot will award 5% in credits for free supplies to the school of your choice.

To Participate: Shop at your nearest Office Depot store and designate our school at check-out by name or our school's 5% Back to Schools ID # 70216506.

Simply clip and save labels from Tyson products that feature the **Project A+ logo**, send them in to our school, and we can then redeem them for **cash** from Tyson. To Participate: Simply cut the ENTIRE Tyson Project A+ LABEL along the dashed line and send to school with your child (preferably in a zip-top baggie or envelope) to be turned in to the Box Tops for Education drop box in the school's front hall.

TARGET – Take Charge of Education. If you use your Target Visa or Target REDcard at a Target store or at target.com, Target will donate an amount equal to 1% of purchases made to the eligible K-12 school of your choice. Additionally, if you use your Target Visa to make purchases elsewhere, Target will donate 1/2% of purchases made to the eligible K-12 school of your choice. To apply for a Target Visa or Target REDcard, go to the Target website at www.target.com/redcard.
